1.3 RIGHTS & OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANISERS:

The Organizers and Stewards of the meet may issue any number of bulletins to competitors' at any time as per the Code with the approval of FMSCI / Stewards. These bulletins shall be posted on the official notice board. Written bulletins when issued shall have the same legal force as these supplementary regulations. All bulletins will be communicated, dated and sequentially numbered and competitors will be informed. These will be posted on the notice board as well as announced on the PA system.

The stewards of the meet are empowered to take a decision on any case not covered by the present regulations. The Stewards of the Meet have the right to delete and / or shorten the track should they deem it necessary or expedient at any time or due to safety or FORCE MAJEURE.

The Organisers will ensure that all relevant permissions are obtained from the competent authorities prior to the event, copies of which must be made available to the Stewards. These permissions are pertaining to the Sporting Aspect of the event.

Note: It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure that all the vehicle(s) they are taking part on are either sold in India or if imported, they will have to be legally imported and with all the relevant documents. That the same has been procured by the Participant in compliance with all applicable laws and fully indemnifying the organisers against all losses, claims, damages, costs suffered by them in this regard.

Please also note that the organizers have no role in ascertaining the legality of the vehicle & is merely collecting the same with necessary precautions on behalf of the Participants to secure the entry. At any given point of time, relevant authorities for reconfirming the legal status of the said vehicle can check the Legality of the paperwork. However, if the documentation submitted by the Participant is found to be forged or false by respected authorities - it is the Participant / Vehicle Owner's responsibility to provide further clarification and not of the organisers.

ARTICLE 3: TRACK

3.1 Surface : Tarmac

Place : Jakkur Aerodrome, Bengaluru

Length of Track : 402 meters

Braking Distance : 500 meters. Braking area of around 500 meters and run-off of 25 meters for the remaining distance.

Width of the Drag Strip is 18 meters as per regulations.

Further width if available.

Stop barrier after the run off area plus sign boards.

Barricading : 525 meters of Barricading on one sides will be of metal and other is restricted to 75 meters as there is no access to public. In the centre for initial 75 to 100 metres it will be of PVC followed by cones.

Fire extinguishers : At Start, Finish, end of track and pit areas.

Fire engine : At Start.

A vehicle may enter only one of the following categories. Only 2 Rider/Drivers per Vehicle are allowed. However a lady participant could take part as the third participant in the same vehicle.

“Drag Racer of the Series”. It will entail:

- **Once the ISW Cup Points have been concluded & winners declared in the respective Classes. The title of Drag Racer of the Series will be ascertained as follows:-**

- 1. Fastest Foreign Car**
- 2. Fastest Foreign Bike**
- 3. Fastest Indian Car**
- 4. Fastest Indian Bike**

The Fastest Timings would be ascertained by the Winners of Respective Categories to Race with each other to arrive at the above stated titles. For example:

- Winner of I2, I3 & J Class to Determine Foreign Car Class: Drag Racer of the Series – Foreign Car
- Winner of M2, M4, M6 to determine Indian Bike Class: Drag Racer of the Series – Indian Bike
- Winner of Indian Open to be determined by Indian Cars Participating in G & J Class to emerge as the Drag Racer of the Series – Indian Car. Note: only Indian Cars Participating in the J Class will be eligible to Race with the Winners of G Class.
- Winners of M7, M9, M10 to determine Foreign Bike Class: Drag Racer of the Series – Foreign Bike

The Drag Racer of the Series (4 Title Holders) will be Awarded Rs. 1lac in addition to the Prizes defined for Specific Classes.

- A. His photographs shall be used by ISW for promotions and brandings for the entire 2018 season.
- B. His participation in ISW Cup the next year shall be free.
- C. He will be given Rs. 1 Lakh to maintain his bike or car.
- D. He will have to put up the logo of ISW on his car or bike for the year 2018.

All the cash awards will be given by ISW and the Promoter AKM Group as per the results.

• **Article 10 - SAFETY: MANDATORY SAFETY COMPLIANCE FOR DRIVERS / RIDERS – 2017 As per FMSCI Guidelines.**

• **10.1 - Safety Gear for 2 Wheelers:**

- Full riding gear for all classes such as overalls, racing helmet, gloves & boots as defined in the 2W Racing Regulations.
- Helmet as per DOT or EC approvals. No Poly Carbonate Helmets are permitted. Knee guards and Elbow guards are compulsory if the overalls do not have them in built.
- 2 piece overall is permitted if both the pieces can be fastened together by means of a zipping system.

• **10.2 - Safety Requirements for 4 Wheelers:**

ROLL CAGES:

- **Super Cars**
- Super Cars running at 9 seconds and faster or at 240 kmph and above : Roll cage and Chutes is mandatory
- Super Cars running at 9.99 seconds and faster: Roll Cage is mandatory.
- Super Cars running at 10 seconds and slower: Roll cage not mandatory.
- Cars with roll cages – 4-point harness mandatory.
- Soft tops & convertibles are not permitted without the prescribed Roll Cage
- **ET HANDICAP RACING (defined on the basis of last 4 years TVR Category Results) STOCK-**

BODY VEHICLES, ALTERED-BODY VEHICLES

- Cars running at 9 seconds and faster or at 240 kmph and above: Roll cage and Chutes is mandatory
- Cars running at 11.99 seconds and faster: Roll Cage is mandatory.
- Cars running at 12 seconds and slower : Roll cage not mandatory.
- Indian Homologated Single Seater Vehicles : Roll cages specified in the FMSCI Racing Regulations & Vehicle Homologation.

- *Non Approved Single Seaters by the FMSCI :*
To confirm to the FIA Drag Specifications.

- Cars running at 9 seconds and faster or at 240 kmph and above: Roll cage and Chutes is mandatory
- **Roll Cage Specifications will be as defined in the FMSCI Technical Regulations pertaining to Roll Cages.**

10.3 - HELMETS:

- All cars running at 11.99 seconds and faster, drivers need to wear Helmets as per specifications defined in the FMSCI Racing Regulations.
- All cars running at 12 seconds and slower, drivers need to wear Helmets with either DOT or EC Approvals. Poly Carbonate Helmets are not permitted.

10.4 - OVERALLS, GLOVES, SHOES:

- All cars running at 11.99 seconds and faster, drivers will need to wear overalls, shoes and gloves as specified in the FMSCI Racing Regulations.
- All cars running at 12 seconds and slower, following needs to be adhered to : Full-length pants; short or long-sleeved shirt; closed shoes; and socks. No shorts. No tank tops. No open-toe or open heel shoes or sandals. Synthetic clothing not recommended.

- **10.5** - Each driver shall be given 1 pit pass per Vehicle entered. Photographs for the pit crew should be presented with the entry form giving the name and the blood group.
